# Defense Export Control and Compliance System (DECCS)

As part of DDTC's IT Modernization effort, the Defense Export Control and Compliance System (DECCS) will become the central online platform for conducting business with DDTC.

### DECCS Industry Portal

DDTC manages several systems to support its core business functions. Read below for more information about each system and the function(s) it supports.

#### DECCS Applications:

Application	Description	Status	Materials & Guidance
Commodity Jurisdictions (CJ)	The <b>Commodity Jurisdiction (CJ) application was the first application released in DECCS.</b> The CJ application allows industry users to electronically complete, sign and submit a CJ request to determine whether an item or service is covered by the U.S. Munitions List (USML) and therefore subject to export controls administered by the Department of State pursuant to the Arms Export Control Act and the ITAR. Upon successful submission, users will immediately receive their CJ case number for status tracking. Opinions (AO)	The Advisory Opinions (AO) application allows industry users to electronically submit <b>inquiries related to ITAR sections 120.22(a), 120.22(c), and 129.9.</b> Use of the application is highly encouraged as a significantly faster alternative to mail-in correspondence, which requires manual data entry and can delay response times. <p>Registration</p>	<p>DDTC maintains a pool of approximately 14,000 registered entities, managing renewals, fees, and account data. DDTC replaced its legacy Electronic Form Submission (EFS) tool with the new Registration application. <p>Licensing</p>	<p>DDTC analyzes and processes approximately 38,000 defense export license applications from industry each year, with input from key interagency partners. DDTC released a new Licensing application to replace its legacy licensing submission system, DTrade.
